Greetings,

We are pleased to inform you that Golden Pyramids Plaza has filed lawsuit No. 890 of Y 18 Q against Orascom Construction Industries, Consolidated Contractors International, and others, requesting that the court acquit it of all amounts awarded by the arbitration ruling issued by the Cairo Regional Center for International Commercial Arbitration on December 17, 2014, in case No. 467 for Y2006. This court's ruling is based on full payment, terminating the binding force and enforceability of the award. The court also orders the first and second defendants (Orascom Construction Industries and Consolidated Contractors International) not to pursue Golden Pyramids Plaza or any of its debtors in any way, whether now or in the future, regarding this award.

This lawsuit, after the referral, was registered under No. 13 of 2026 and a ruling was issued in the session of 31/3/2026 stating that "the court has no subject-matter jurisdiction to consider the lawsuit and referred it in its current state to the competent execution judge at the New Cairo Primary Court, and set a session for its consideration on 17/5/2026.

However, the case was not heard at the session of 17/5/2026. Upon further inquiry, we had known that the case file has not yet been transferred to the New Cairo Court due to two appeals against the aforementioned ruling. The first appeal was filed by Orascom Construction Industries against Golden Pyramids Plaza and others, registered under number 785 of Y 19 Q, and scheduled for a hearing on 20/6/2026, before the Seventh Economic Appeals Circuit. The second appeal was filed by Golden Pyramids Plaza against Orascom Construction Industries and others, registered under number 824 of Y 19 Q, and scheduled for a hearing on 21/6/ 2026, before the Seventh Economic Appeals Circuit.

Please also be advised that you will be notified of any final judgments issued regarding the aforementioned lawsuits.
